Parent Informational Sheet

What Link2Learn School Day?

Webster County's Link2Learn days are Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) days provided by the Kentucky Department of Education to approved school districts. NTI days provide instruction on designated days when it is not possible (weather/emergency) for school to be in session. Link2Learn Days allow students to be engaged in skill reinforcement, content enrichment or remediation through electronic and conventional paper lessons. The result is less loss of instructional time and the reduction of the number of make-up days at the end of a school year. Link2Learn days count as regular student attendance

When will Link2 Learn days occur?

The option to implement Link2Learn days will be dependent upon the weather forecast, the number of days missed, and the impact upon learning.

How will I know it is a Link2Learn day?:

- You will receive a One-Call automated phone message from Webster County School District
- General information about Link2Learn will be posted on the district website: www.webster.kyschools.us as well as the Webster County School District Facebook page and SchoolWay.

Teacher Availability:

Teachers will be accessible through the Internet 8:00 AM-11:00 AM & 12:00 PM-3:00 PM. Teachers may be reached by email or through a digital platform identified by the teacher (e.g., Google Classroom, Edmodo, Remind App). If a teacher does not have Internet access, another form of communication will be provided.

Instructional Delivery/Assignments:

Both digital and paper assignments will be available for students on Link2Learn days.

Digital Assignments: For digital assignments, students should login to the teacher's webpage for the Link2Learn assignments. 1) Go to www.webster.kyschools.us, 2) Click into "Click Here To Access Teacher Webpages" located on the upper left hand corner of the district homepage; 3) Find your child's school and select teacher(s); and 4) Select the Link2Learn assignment on teacher's webpage.

Paper Assignment: Paper assignments will be provided to any student without Internet access. Teachers may also provide paper assignments in addition to digital assignments.

Student Responsibility/Accountability:

Students are required to complete all Link2Learn assignments. Students have up to three days to submit all Link2Learn assignments.
